## ***2020 Filing Notice for Bertie County Board of Education & Soil and Water Conservation***

The Bertie County Board of Elections will conduct the election for the Nonpartisan Bertie County Board of Education & Soil and Water Conservation District Supervisor on Tuesday – November 3, 2020. Candidates seeking election to the Bertie County Board of Education and Soil and Water Conservation shall file their Notice of Candidacy at the office of the Bertie County Board of Elections.

***Filing dates*** – Candidates filing shall begin no earlier than **noon** on Monday – June 8, 2020. Candidate filing shall end no later than **noon** on Monday – July 6, 2020. All Notices of Candidacy, together with the proper filing fee, must be in the possession of the Bertie County Board of Elections by the deadline to be accepted.

### ***Board of Education offices on the 2020 General ballot include:***

- District 1 Board Member – 1 seat (4-year term)
- District 5 Board Member – 1 seat (4-year term)

### ***Soil and Water Conservation District offices on the 2020 General ballot include:***

- District Supervisor – 1 seat (4-year terms)

The Elections Office is currently closed to the public. Staff continues to work Monday through Friday (8:30 AM – 5:00 PM). Visits are by appointment only. As always candidates have the option to file their notarized notice of candidacy and filing fee with our office by mail.
