## GUIDE TO RESTORING POWER TO EXISTING RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURES

- 1. Get Electrician to check for electrical safety.
- 2. Each entrance must have safe access. (Steps or ramp with handrails that met code when the Certificate of Occupancy was issued.)
- 3. Must have safe access to Electrical equipment and home. (No overgrown weeds and brush with the potential to hide hazards, such as snakes, holes in the ground, boards with nails, or other sharp objects.
- 4. No large holes in exterior walls, roof/ceiling or floors.
- 5. House must be in a safe, livable condition.
- 6. Address must be posted on the front of the house with numbers a minimum of 4" tall on contrasting background, so as to be visible from the road.
- 7. In some cases, inspector may choose to issue a temporary power only.
